PFESIDENT ROBAK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 1 nay to place the house under call.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The house is under call. Will senators please return to their seats. Will all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Will senators please check in. Senators, please check in. Senator Cudaback, Senator Maurstad, Senator Hartnett. We are waiting for Senator Hartnett. The question before you is the advancement of LR 41CA. Senator Brown requested a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, please proceed.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 650-51 of the Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 22 nays on the advancement, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LR 41CA fails to advance. I raise the call. We now turn to LB 349.

CLERK: Madam President, 349, a bill originally introduced by Senators Robak, and Dierks, and Jones. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 11, last year. At that time it was referred to the Education Committee for hearing. There are Education Committee amendments pending. I do have a series of amendments to those amendments. However, I have a priority motion, Madam President. Senator Bohlke would move to bracket Legislative Bill 349 until Wednesday, February 2nd (sic).

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Chair recognizes Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes, Madam President, and members, I have about three reasons for this motion. First of all, certainly, as you know, the Education Committee took on the issue of school finance as its only major interim study this last session. We have certainly looked at income tax rebate, how that's treated in the formula, and what our recommendations may (sic) or may be. The hearing is today, this afternoon, in the Education Committee, on that bill and also LB 1145, which also talks about major things in the education bill on school aid formulas. And so my first reason for the bracket is saying, even if you support the idea of introducing income in the formula, this has
