

have gotten to a vote. What we would have gotten to was some of the amendments and, as I said to those of you who are interested in income tax rebate and what that happens, that very well could have been one of the amendments we would have gotten to and so you need to consider if you wanted to get into that discussion and that debate today, or if you wanted to see what comes out of the Education Committee. All of us that are the...all of the committees hearing things on property tax relief are hearing them in these two weeks. There has been a general agreement we will try to get something out, the recommendations from those committees, and up to you and the body. That's why I went ahead and designated it as a priority bill, even before it was out of committee, to make sure that I could get to you early. We could have the discussion, we could all consider the recommendations of the Education Committee, and at that time, certainly amendments can be offered. We can discuss the issue of introducing income as a formula. I am not saying that it's...I am not talking about the issue. I am just saying it could be the right issue, it's the wrong time. And so, with that, I ask you to join Senator Wickersham and me, and I've had conversations with other members of the Education Committee, not all of them, but certainly an indication that we would like to have that opportunity to have before you the recommendations of the Education Committee before we begin to debate income into the formula as a factor. So for those reasons, I continue to ask you to support the bracket bill to next week. Thank you.
