

bill to make those distinctions. And the issues that Senator Chambers is now bringing up, this is, this law is written specifically to address those issues. There is a division here. There is a division between the people who would be involved in the child pornography. There is a division between the people who would be involved in kidnapping. As in I said, these, these specific issues were brought to us not by the federal government, but by people within Nebraska who came up and told us about their experiences.

SENATOR CROSBY: One minute.

SENATOR WITEK: The kidnapping areas are the Jill Cutshall, Mrs. Cutshall up there in the Norfolk area, she talked to us about having the need to have this in this law. So these are Nebraskans who are coming to us making this law better so it better fits their specific circumstances. I can see no reason to have any...any second thoughts about adopting...this amendment of Senator Abboud's actually makes this better and I appreciate Senator Beutler bringing this up, to say that we have to have experts to make this determination, which is an extra, I guess, defense for the individual who would be in this court case. And if you notice, it's just Section 5 of the bill, just that level that Senator Wesely just talked about of that 10 to 15 percent of those individuals who may need more, more oversight. We are trying to have the registry include all sex offenders, but just those 10 to 15 percent will be subject to Section 5 of this bill. So we do make a determination here and I would think Senator Chambers and everyone on the floor would be in favor of this amendment...

SENATOR CROSBY: Time.

SENATOR WITEK: ...and this bill.
