If they are not accepted by the profession and there is no definition of these terms, a judge could arbitrarily make a determination that a person is a violent sexual offender who has to do this registering and filling out of these forms for at least a ten-year period, with no chance to have that requirement taken away. So among the offenses that could cause a person, and I'm saying what I'm saying for the record, because I think somebody should challenge this law if it becomes the law, there are nonsexual offenses that can cause a person to be given this label. What we have done is to list nonsexual offenses, and let's say that a person is determined to have this personality disorder, maybe he just likes to do it, kidnapping is one of them. So this person has a personality disorder that is likely to make him kidnap again. That makes this person a violent sexual offender who must register for ten years after being released from prison for kidnapping. And yet there was nothing sexual involved in the kidnapping. The kidnapping was not done to sexually harm the person kidnapped. It was not harm to wrest sexual favors from anybody. It's just doing that act which constitutes kidnapping under the law. And if it's found that this person has a mental abnormality or personality disorder that's likely to cause that person to kidnap again, even for no sexual reason, that person, under...

SENATOR CROSBY: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ..this law, is a violent sexual offender. I know that this bill is going to go, but I'm going to offer some amendments to try to strike that language. And if it's not stricken, I will have done all that I can do to try to bring some rationality to this highly emotional, irrational approach that the body seems intent on taking.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Chambers. There are no further lights on this amendment. Senator Abboud, would you like to close?

SENATOR ABOUD: I would urge the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the Abboud amendment to the committee amendments. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on the Abboud amendment. Have you all voted? Record, please.
