SENATOR CHAMBERS: ..when she goes off the deep end, as I think she has on this bill. But knowing as I do that the senators are going to run it through because they will use it in their reelection campaigns, I know it's going to advance. But I bet not one of them will say, this was done because a federal government ordered it. At the same time they're going to tell people how they stand up to the federal government and are against incursions into people's lives by the federal government. And I would say to Senator Pirsch and everybody else, no matter how reprehensible conduct is or a person is who is accused of that, I'm going to do all I can, nevertheless, to make sure such persons do not have their rights violated or infringed upon.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Wesely. Do I see five hands? I do. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I would object to the question on the basis that there hasn't been but a couple of speakers on the, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Beutler, I reread that rule this morning, and it indicates that, that I have the option of ruling the question out of order, and I am not going to rule the question out of order at this point. Do I see five hands? I do. The question before the body is, shall debate now cease? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Debate is ceased. Senator Abboud, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR ABOUD: I would urge the body to advance the bill. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The question before the body now is, shall LB 645 be advanced to E & R Initial? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. A record vote has been requested. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote.) 37 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the advancement.
