SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Robinson. Senator Chambers, on the Government Committee confirmation report.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I have to use this report to correct what I said. This case involved Dennis Ryan and second degree murder, not Michael Ryan. So I have been corrected by Senator Vrtiska, who was right on the case, and I wanted the opportunity to correct it the same morning that I made my mistake. But I'm still hopeful that the right thing might be done in all these death penalty cases.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Robinson, closing.

SENATOR ROBINSON: I'd just like to say they're common sense confirmations, and I would like to see a positive vote for all of them.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the confirmation report. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
