the position where we have those types of people who are among us. And if we can do nothing else, at least a start in the direction of trying to protect our kids from this kind of abuse, I don't know what else we can do. Maybe as we move ahead there will be other checks on other people. But I just think it's important that we understand that, in fact, these are the kinds of things that are happening in our society today and so that makes me ashamed. But that doesn't do away with the problem. And the only way that I know that we can at least have a start in the direction of trying to protect these kids is to pass this kind of legislation. And I would hope that the members of the body would understand that and would be willing to at least advance this bill and discuss it more thoroughly, and in the long term make it become law. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. Before we continue, I would like to call the Legislature's attention to the fact that we do have a doctor of the day today. Dr. Jay Matzke, from Omaha, he's our own Senator Matzke's son, and with him today are two of his children, Jared and Sloane. Are you under the so...north balcony? There he is.
