SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Madam President, members of the body. This amendment, I assume, will be agreed to. And again, if those that have taken time to read the bill carefully, you'd get to...it's on Section 5 on the committee amendments. It says, "The Nebraska State Patrol shall adopt and promulgate rules and regs to carry out Sections 1 through 4." If you read Sections 1 through 4, it's dealing with education, the setting of certificates, the setting up a process. Why anyone would want to have the State Patrol do that, set rules and regs for education, is beyond me. This amendment simply strikes the "State Patrol", "Nebraska State Patrol", and inserts "the Department of Education". So the amendment, if agreed to, would read, on Section 5, "The Department of Education shall adopt and promulgate rules and regs to carry out Sections 1 through 4 of this act." That's the nature of the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. Discussion on the amendment. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, I'm going to listen to additional discussion on that part of the amendment. But before I get to that amendment itself, there are a couple of things that I have to get some preliminary information on, and I'll ask Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Bohlke, will you yield?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Bohlke, in the committee amendment, starting in Section 1, and I'm going to try to work my way through, unless Senator Schrock calls the question again. In line 6, the first line 6, where we're talking about a complete set of fingerprints, from whence will come these fingerprints, because the applicant submits them?

SENATOR BOHLKE: It would have to come from the State Patrol, or if they would...the applicant themselves, if they would have to get it from some law enforcement agency.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But it doesn't say that, does it? It just says, all applicants for the first issuance shall file a
