SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Hilgert. Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Call the question.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. The question before the body is ceasing debate.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Call of the house too, Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: A call of the house has been requested. All in favor of the house going under call please vote aye. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 2 nays to place the house under call, Mr. President.

Senator Avery, Senator Cudaback, Senator Wesely, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. There's been a request for reverse order. We will have a roll call vote in reverse order on ceasing debate, and we're still waiting for Senator Wesely. And there's Senator Wesely. The issue before the body is calling the question. A roll call vote, in reverse order, has been requested. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 719 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 10 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.
