SENATOR COORDSEN: And I did this rather hurriedly, and just...provided the amendment, we may have a substitute amendment here...

SENATOR PIRSCH: Good, I...

SENATOR COORDSEN:...in just a few moments.

SENATOR PIRSCH: I am hoping maybe that you could do a substitute amendment and I surely would support what you're trying to get at, but I do think we need to make clear instead of just striking this amendment and keeping it silent. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Pirsch. There are no further lights. Senator Coordsen, would you like to close on your amendment? Senator Coordsen, to close.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Madam President. We have a conference going over here, and given...given the intricacies of law in regard to this, I am going to recommend this morning that we adopt this amendment, which strikes 7 through 13, and I am sure that 584 will come up on Final Reading rather quickly, and we will then offer an amendment that will be more constructive to address some of the concerns on the floor of the body.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Senator Beutler, that was his closing.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: The question is the adoption of the Coordsen amendment to LB 584. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are on Final Reading. You should be in your seats, and we are voting on the Coordsen amendment. Have you all voted? Record, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 10 nays on the adoption of Senator Coordsen's amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted. Senator Coordsen, do you want to move to readvance the bill?
