ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 733 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 39 ayes, 0 nays, 10 excused and not voting.

SENATOR COORDSEN: LB 898 passes. LB 899.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 899 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 899 pass? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 734 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 39 ayes, 0 nays, 10 excused and not voting.

SENATOR COORDSEN: LB 899 passes. That concludes Final Reading. The next agenda item is Select File, Mr. Clerk. LB 700A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, with respect to LB 700A, I do have E & R amendments.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 700A.
