SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President. I'd move to advance LB 256A to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Lynch.

SENATOR LYNCH: I apologize for not getting your attention earlier, and to Senator Maurstad. As representing the Retirement Committee and the only one here on the floor was advised by our good counsel... Appropriations, I mean, we would ask that we pass over 256A, and do you know why, Senator Hudkins? Are you sure why we're... do you know why we're requesting it be passed over? The reason we are requesting it be laid over was that we have some revised figures that would be necessary and included in the A bill. And since it's on Select File, if it could be just laid over until those numbers are finalized and given to Senator Hudkins, we'd appreciate it.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Hudkins.

SENATOR HUDKINS: Mr. President and members of the body, I'm sorry. Yes, I was about a half step behind. Like Senator Vrtiska said this morning, I don't have Alzheimer's, I have "halfheimers." I only remember half of what I have to do, and so, yes, based on the fact that we will be getting revised figures, I would also request that this bill be passed over.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Hudkins. LB 256A passed over. LB 939, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, on LB 939, I do have E & R amendments.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 939.

SENATOR COORDSEN: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The E & R amendments are adopted.
