SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Yes.

SENATOR ROBINSON: That she could go to the Legislative Fiscal Office.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: That is correct.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Senator Witek, are you listening?

SENATOR WITEK: Yes, Senator Robinson, I am listening.

SENATOR ROBINSON: I think on part (10) there, I think that's available to you now if you want to go to the Legislative Fiscal Office. I think...I think you could...I know I've never had any trouble with that, you know, getting itemized costs for new employees and contracted services. I don't know, maybe...maybe you haven't been able to do that, but I've always been able to do that. That's why...now I agree (11) is a different issue, but I think (10), subsection (10) there is available to you right now.

SENATOR WITEK: Well, I...it was not available within the fiscal note, and so I assumed...

SENATOR ROBINSON: Did you call the Fiscal Office?

SENATOR WITEK: ...and I could dig, I could dig. I don't think we've had time...

SENATOR ROBINSON: Yeah, I really do. I think it might be available to you now. If it isn't, I'd like to know if it isn't.

SENATOR WITEK: Okay, I'll check on that.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Yeah.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Robinson. Senator Witek.

SENATOR WITEK: Thank you very much. Well, I appreciate your discussion I guess on 1141, Senator Bernard-Stevens. I am sorry that I missed it on your first one, but my amendment would not limit appropriations. I wish I could offer amendments to limit some appropriations in this area, but you are right,
