

registration...for being late on registration, and dealt with motor vehicles. And in the repeal there was nothing left, so the bill reinstates the same sections that refer to the interest to be paid on payments that are late that were current law, but puts them in the motor vehicle section rather than in the obsolete property tax section. And then the other is a variety of responsibilities that would also have gone to the property tax administrator who previously would have gone to the...generally to the Department of Revenue, or the head of the department. But these include some of the review processes required for state aid that was inadvertently left out of 490. None of this makes any change. It also strikes from the language some of the powers to review cases regarding illegal, unconstitutional mistake in taxes, which was inconsistent with other laws that are already in place and handle those. So it's all harmonizing, clarifying, no substantive change of any kind. With that, I'd move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT^M ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Warner. Is there any discussion of the advancement of LB 1038? Seeing none, Senator Warner, to close. Closing is waived. The question before you is the advancement of LB 1038. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 1038 advances. LB 1039.

ASSISTANT CLERK: LB 1039 was introduced by the Revenue Committee. (Read title.) The bill was read for the first time on January 4th of this year, referred to the Revenue Committee, they report the bill to General File with no committee amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner to open on the bill.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, this bill was brought to us by the department, again makes no substantive change. It's solely for the purpose of clarification in a few areas on homestead exemptions. One of the changes that are made a number of places is the words or the term "surviving spouse", and it's changed to the more general
