SENATOR ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. I am a little confused here. Are we on an amendment, or are we on the committee amendments, or where are we? Could you tell me?.

SENATOR COORDSEN: We are on the committee amendments. The amendment to the amendment by Senator Withem has been withdrawn. We are on the committee amendments, as we were the last time we talked about this bill.

SENATOR ROBAK: We did not ever talk about this bill before. We bracketed it before we got to talk about it, so...

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you for the reminder, Senator Robak.

SENATOR ROBAK: Okay, so we are on the bill, right? Correct?

SENATOR COORDSEN: Yes.

SENATOR ROBAK: Okay, thank you very much. Oh, it is the bill.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Robak, we are on the committee amendment to the bill.

SENATOR ROBAK: Okay.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Okay.

SENATOR ROBAK: All right, we are on the bill...committee amendments, basically, is the bill, but what I am doing, amendment I have, AM2882, which strikes Section 4 of the bill, and that brings us back to 349 in its original context, which is the intent of the bill. I would like 349 with my amendment, 2882.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Yes, Senator Robak, the Clerk informed me that you do have amendments to the bill, but there are amendments on file ahead of yours.

SENATOR ROBAK: Okay, well, then I will just talk to the bill, since I have some time left. I introduced this bill because it would make a change in our school finance formula. Our current system was put in place, as Senator Withem said, by 1059 which was passed in 1990. I have a good handout here, which I would ask the Pages to come forward at this time. It is a very good
