PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. The question before the body is the vote on the motion to reconsider the Robak amendment to the committee amendments to LB 349. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to reconsider.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: And the motion to reconsider is successful. We return to a discussion of the Robak amendment. Is there any discussion on the Robak amendment? Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Madam President and members of the body, Senator Robak, I have this handout that your assistant gave me. Could you go through that for me, Senator Robak?

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Robak.

SENATOR ROBAK: Excuse me, Senator Robinson. I was...

SENATOR ROBINSON: I want you to take me through this sheet that I received from your legal aide.

SENATOR ROBAK: I'll have to get it.

SENATOR ROBINSON: It says, the second paragraph says, local effort rate is determined annually, it's based on needs, income tax fund rebates, other receipts, and so forth.

SENATOR ROBAK: Yes.

SENATOR ROBINSON: And for state funds available for equal...now, from there on will you go into some depth on that for me.

SENATOR ROBAK: Yes, yes, I can.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Like where it says the district income tax factor is based on the following equation.

SENATOR ROBAK: I'll have to get to my amendment on this...Senator Wickersham, do you have the two-page handout there, where the formula, Senator Robinson.
