

February 14, 1996 LB 438, 1008, 1047

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 1008.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 1008 advances. LB 1047.

CLERK: LB 1047 introduced by Senator Fisher. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 4, referred to the Business and Labor Committee, advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Abboud to open on the committee amendments.

SENATOR ABOUD: Thank you, Madam President. The Business and Labor Committee amendment to LB 1047 corrects a slight drafting error in the bill. The language as originally written implies that the student work permit program is or would be a self-supporting program with the change in fees. Only the boiler inspection program is intended to be self supporting. The student work permit program only changes a small fee to the applicants, though the fee will increase, it will not become self supporting. The language of the amendment corrects that erroneous impression. I move for the adoption of the committee amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion on the committee amendments? Seeing none, Senator Abboud to close. Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 1047. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of committee amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The committee amendments are adopted. The Chair recognizes Senator Fisher to open on the bill.

SENATOR FISHER: Madam President and members, this bill seems to have a small cloud over it occasionally, but we're working our way through it. In 1995 I carried bill, LB 438, for the Department of Labor. This was a bill to make the boiler inspection program self supporting. After it passed the department discovered that 438 and another bill, LB 330, lacked
