SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the Wickersham amendment to the committee amendments of LB 1050. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are voting on the Wickersham amendment to the committee amendments to 1050. Have you all voted? Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Madam President, I would request a call of the house and a roll call vote, please.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. There's a request for a call of the house and a roll call vote. All in favor of the call of the house vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: The house is under call. Would all senators please check in, record your presence. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Would all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Senator Abboud, Senator Chambers, Senator Preister, the house is under call. Senator Dierks, Senator Schellpeper, Senator Schmitt, the house is under call. Senator Withem and Senator Landis, the house is under call. Senator Dierks, would you please check in. Senator Schmitt, would you check in. Senator Dierks. All present and accounted for. We are voting on the Wickersham amendment to the committee amendments to LB 1050. A roll call vote in regular order has been requested. Mr. Clerk, would you call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 813-14 of the Legislative Journal.) 17 ayes, 22 nays, Madam President, on the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is not adopted. I will raise the call. Mr. Clerk.
