SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes.

SENATOR ABBODD: Senator Bohlke, are we talking about Section 9 of the committee amendments, with the income tax? Is that what basically this amendment, this section of the amendment is?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes, we're on the income tax rebate.

SENATOR ABBODD: Now the option student section is taken out in an earlier amendment, I believe that was the first amendment that we discussed (inaudible).

SENATOR BOHLKE: That was the first division.

SENATOR ABBODD: And how much, as far as this particular section, since the option section has been taken out of the committee amendment, do you know what the shift in funds is with this, with this section, with this particular amendment?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Right, Senator Abboud, just one, quickly, the option hasn't been taken out. We voted to...it's still in the bill. But the difference with the 101 million that we just did as compared to what?

SENATOR ABBODD: Well, compared to current statute.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Currently, in...60 million.

SENATOR ABBODD: So it's...

SENATOR BOHLKE: No, no, no, I'm sorry, that's incorrect. Income...that can't be right. Income tax rebate currently, say last year that went out to schools...

SENATOR ABBODD: Yes.

SENATOR BOHLKE: It would be reduced by 22 million.

SENATOR ABBODD: Twenty-two million?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes.
