SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Bohlke. You heard the closing. The issue before the body is division two of the committee amendments, Floor Amendment 438, the income tax rebate. Those in favor of this amendment please vote aye, those opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Floor Amendment 438.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Floor Amendment 438 is adopted. Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President, thank you. The committee on Banking reports LB 1203 General File with amendments, LB 1376 General File with amendments, LB 1071 indefinitely postponed, LB 1086, and LR 90 all indefinitely postponed. Judiciary reports LB 1100 General File, LB 1346 General File, LB 957 General File with amendments, LB 1285 indefinitely postponed, and LB 1348 indefinitely postponed. Hearing notices from General Affairs Committee. Senator Withem, amendment (sic) to LB 952, Senator Bernard-Stevens to LB 1141. And Select File, reports LB 1108 to Select File, LB 967, LB 1072, LB 938, LB 1073, LB 905, LB 906 all to Select File. (See pages 815-21 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, the next portion of the committee amendments, offered by the Education Committee, chaired by Senator Bohlke. Senator, I believe you want to take up the transportation provisions now, is that what you'd like to do?

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR BOHLKE: I'm not sure if it's what I'd like to do, but, yes, that is the next division.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Bohlke, did you want to start on this portion of the division? (FA437 is referred to on page 784 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes, Mr. President, thank you. I really do thank everyone who have worked through, I think, two of not only the more difficult, but the more controversial provisions of LB 1050. I hope that you all now have a better understanding of school finance. I'm sure that you do. It is difficult and it's
