on. And if you have any concerns about what your positions might be with regard to a different portion of school costs and aid to schools, you may also wish to think about that aspect of this policy change. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Madam President and members of the body. Senator Bohlke, would, could I carry on a little conversation with you?

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes.

SENATOR JANSSEN: In referring to schools that provide transportation now, who don't have to, that is a Class VI school. Class VI school does not have to provide transportation...

SENATOR BOHLKE: That's correct.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...under the current formula.

SENATOR BOHLKE: That's correct.

SENATOR JANSSEN: So any time they have, and if they choose to do so, I don't know how many Class VI schools choose to use transportation or to provide it, but there are some. Under the current formula they cannot use that cost against their equalization.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Right.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right.

SENATOR BOHLKE: It's counted as part of their tier.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right. Under this amendment will they be able to?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes.
