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SENATOR ROBINSON: I don't know.

SENATOR BOHLKE: To make a recommendation to their board.

SENATOR ROBINSON: I don't know. But I know there're,...

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes.

SENATOR ROBINSON: ...I know there are a lot of...

SENATOR BOHLKE: I've read the...

SENATOR ROBINSON: ...community groups that questioned.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Right.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Also in the Afro-American community, they even questioned...

SENATOR BOHLKE: Right.

SENATOR ROBINSON: ...what they're doing.

SENATOR BOHLKE: And I read those same articles, Senator Robinson, and asked the Omaha school districts and I think at their last meeting they announced that they are doing a major study to determine if they will continue to have the same policy they have today.

SENATOR ROBINSON: So you're saying we...if that's not changed we should look at it, huh?

SENATOR BOHLKE: I'm not opposed...

SENATOR ROBINSON: It seems to me...

SENATOR BOHLKE: I'm not opposed to looking at it.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Yeah, because why should they, they not be looked and everyone else is looked at? So that's my comments, thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Robinson. Senator Cudaback.
