SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Abboud. Mr. Clerk, third resolution.

CLERK: Senators Wesely, Bromm, and Abboud offer 321. (Read summary of LR 321.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: Reluctantly, Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Oh, Senator Coordsen. Senator Bromm, whose district Wahoo is in, and myself were, my family is from Wahoo, very interested in this possibility. Senator Abboud signed on with us.
