So, having said that, I don't have a problem with seeing this portion voted down and proceed to Senator Withem's amendment which perhaps addresses it in a more timely fashion.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Warner. Any further discussion on the first half of the Warner amendment? Seeing none, the question is the adoption of the first three lines of AM3248 introduced by Senator Warner. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on the first three lines of Senator Warner's amendment. Have you all voted? Record, please.

CLERK: 7 ayes, 18 nays, Madam President, on the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: That part of the amendment is not adopted. Mr. Speaker, did you wish to be recognized?

SPEAKER WITHEM: Yes, I do. When we drew up today's agenda you may have noticed that we had some other items for consideration here at eleven o'clock. This seems to be an appropriate time to move to those. Would also.... So I would indicate to the body that...I would request that the Chair now proceed to consideration of General File, LB 964. The rationale for that, that was a bill of Senator Cudaback that got hung up and has been off the agenda for a while, hopefully won't take a tremendous amount of time today. Would also use this opportunity to remind members, tomorrow at noon we need your priority designations read in. So there are a few senators that have not made their priority designation and a few committees that have not done so yet. We need those priority designations by tomorrow. So, thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. We will advance to LB 964. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, 964, introduced by Senator Cudaback and other members. (Read title.) The bill was discussed, Madam President, on February 1, at that time Senator Cudaback opened on the bill, amendments were offered by Senators Schimek and Chambers that were adopted. I do have an additional amendment.
