SENATOR COORDSEN: The resolution is adopted. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a confirmation report from the Revenue Committee, found on page 742 of the Journal.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the confirmation report here is from the members of the new Tax Equalization and Review Commission, it was three individuals--Mark P. Reynolds, who is a Deputy County Attorney in Sarpy County, and had done part of the work in those...his responsibilities there with valuations and hearings; Janet L...and he also would serve as chairman of the commission; and then Janet L. Edwards, who is a former County Assessor for a number of years in Howard County; and then Robert L. Hans, who is from the first Congressional District, who's had a number of assignments for some various committees and commissions, such as the Planning Commission. He served also as a...on boards which were to determine valuations. But all three members have, I believe, experience. We had a very long public hearing. They certainly understand the importance and the significance of this new commission relative to equalization of values, and the Revenue Committee unanimously has voted to recommend their confirmation to the Legislature for those three positions on the Tax Equalization and Review Commission.
