SPEAKER WITHEM: The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 11 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. The house is under call. Members, please take your seats and check in. Members outside the Chamber please return. The house is under call. Senator Landis, Senator Schimek, Senator Wesely, Senator Matzke, and Senator Lindsay. Senator Landis, Senator Wesely, Senator Lindsay. Still looking for Senator Wesely and Senator Lindsay. SPEAKER WITHEM: And Senator Bohlke also.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend. On page 1 in line 6 after "offenses" strike all language through the act in line 15.
