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of child abuse section, and I think it will help to make this...this work a little bit better for our bill. So, that's why I'm offering the amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Abboud. The only light I have on is Senator Abboud. Did you have something else you wanted to say? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I'd like to ask Senator Abboud what his amendment does. Senator Abboud, did we get a copy?

SENATOR ABOUD: It's up...filed up there.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. I don't have one, so could you tell what it does.

SENATOR ABOUD: I'll let you look at it, if you'd like. It...Senator Beutler, I think he has a copy up there.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then I'm going to read the language...

SENATOR ABOUD: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...so the others may not have a copy. "Any person who is found guilty of sexual assault of a child under this section and who has previously been convicted (a) under this section, (b) under section 28-319 of first degree or attempted first degree sexual assault, or (c) in any other state or federal court under laws with essentially the same elements as this section, or section 28-319, shall be guilty of a Class IC felony." What is a Class IC felony?

SENATOR ABOUD: Class IC, that...I don't know the exact penalty. That...that's one of the classifications under felonies, IC.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: What is...what is the penalty now?

SENATOR ABOUD: I don't have...I don't have...that's what we currently have in law dealing with IC felony. I don't...I don't know the exact...(inaudible).

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And the reason I'm asking you, because I just
