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be abnormal, and it will cost me money. But in the same way that I had to spend money to get a mandamus in a case where the Attorney General said it could not be done, I will do it in this case to show the Legislature how wrong you are. But I will not take all the money out of my pocket, I will try to raise money to challenge it. This is irresponsible, this is wrong. And although I've talked about it from the standpoint of the death penalty,...

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...there are other things in the way...

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Chambers, your light is next, if you want to just continue into your next five minutes, you may do so.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And I'm going to take about 30 seconds to finish this statement, then I'm going to yield the time that remains to Senator Beutler. There are other things which a bill of this kind will encourage counties to do. I also say it is one of those cynical enactments that will cause people to lose respect for the integrity of our process. There is not to be money put in the fund, that's what they said. There is not to be enough money put here to help anybody other than Richardson County. But all of this talk by others about the reduction in the amount of property tax that can be gathered in because of caps and how this might come in handy, but yet no money is to be put in the fund, and its design is to help only Richardson County, so why all of the smoke screen, the discussion of these noble goals and principles and ideas, when they have nothing to do with what we're talking about? Richardson County got itself into a bind, people find Senator Vrtiska's arguments and those of people who came down here to support the bill alluring, and they went for it and put the bill on the floor of the Legislature. Well, I don't go for it and I'm going to fight it in every way that I can. And I give the rest of my time to Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Beutler, you have about three and a half minutes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I call the question.
