SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Would all senators please check in. The house is under call. Senator "Alexander", if you'd check in, please. The house is under call. Would all senators please come to the Chamber. Senator Schimek, would you check in, please. Senator Wehrbein, would you check in, please. Senator Fisher, would you check in, please. Senator Kristensen. All members that are not excused being present, Senator Chambers has asked for a roll call vote. The Clerk will call the roll. Senator Vrtiska has asked that the roll call be in reverse order. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 903-04 of the Legislative Journal.) 6 ayes, 29 nays on the amendment.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: The amendment is not agreed to. Mr. Clerk, any items for the record? If not, we'll go to the next amendment.

CLERK: I can wait at this time, Mr. President, thank you.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Next amendment, please.
