SENATOR VRTISKA: Senator Hillman, I would hope...I would intend to look at that on Select File.

SENATOR HILLMAN: Okay, so then you would look at a method of repayment, and what that scheduling would be, and so forth?

I guess I'll let this go on Select...to Select File, but I guess it's as good a time to read into my...read into the record at this point on this wording because, first of all, on the loan, is there going to be any provisions, how will the determination of loan be repayments, who will be responsible for determining the loan repayment scheduling, if it's a loan? Whose decision is that?

SENATOR VRTISKA: Senator, I just had to speak with my counsel. Yeah, we intend to work this out before it comes up...when it gets on Select File and have an answer ready for you at that time. I know this is an issue that needs to be resolved, and so we put it in there merely to get it to that point, so that when we get to Select File, we can discuss it and give you definite answers.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Do you have other amendments or the committee amendments at this point? I want to get something in the record, I'm not sure whether to do it now or in another ten minutes, and that's the reason I'm asking?

SENATOR VRTISKA: No, I don't have any other amendments.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay, I think on the committee...I'll support this at this point, but I do have some questions I want to read
