course prescribed target shall be the Federal Bureau of Investigation's 'Q' target." Now we had a very serious discussion on the last bill. This is a very serious bill, and this clause raises some serious concerns with me. I watch Star Trek, and on Star Trek, they have something referred to as the Continuum. An individual, who is a part of that Continuum or resides in that Continuum is virtually immortal and may be close to being all-powerful and that person is referred to as "Q". There are other people who qualify as being "Q". This man, if a man it is, it takes the form of a man, but some have taken the form of a female. Are you telling me that the FBI have contrived a target that looks like "Q" and law enforcement officers all over this state are going to be shooting at a likeness of this individual that I find charming, delightful, engaging? Is that what you're telling me?

SENATOR SCHMITT: Well, Senator Chambers, I don't know whether you would find this individual as charming, but I don't believe that I would. A "Q" target, basically, is kind of like a bowling pin or I guess a silhouette target, which would be the head and the torso of an individual without the arms and legs. It is just a...I think a picture of it was shown in the committee that day but I don't if you were there or not.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, but it would not be a likeness of the individual that I've described?

SENATOR SCHMITT: No, no.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: With that reassurance, and I feel much better, Senator Schmitt, I am going to support adoption of the committee amendments, and I will support advancement of the bill.
