CLERK: Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 1035, LB 1001, LB 972, and LB 973 to Select File, some of which have Enrollment and Review amendments attached. Senator Lindsay has amendments to be printed to LB 1055. Communication from the Governor. (Read communication re. LB 939 being signed by Governor.) Your Committee on Judiciary reports LB 943 as indefinitely postponed. That's signed by Senator Lindsay. And Revenue Committee reports LB 1253 to General File; and LB 1290 to General File, signed by Senator Warner. Finally, Mr. President, Senator Lindsay would like to add his name to LB 681 as cointroducer. That's all that I have. (See pages 911-19 of the Legislative Journal.)
