

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: ... (inaudible) of allowing, and I know that from your philosophic point of view that you have in mind what you want to do with implementing language. Senator Schmit, not our Senator Schmitt, but that less famous senator that was prior to Senator Bromm, always had a saying that brought me to mind. He said, you know, they could do exactly the opposite of what you want to do, and laugh at you for doing it. And that was the year of ag land values, when we all wanted to go to 80 percent. He said, there's nothing that prevents them from going to 120 percent. The same danger here is constitutionally I know what I want to do, you know what you want to do, my fear is that there will be other people who will use that language as an opportunity to do things that may not be in the best interest, we may box ourselves in, and you also may have some possibilities for abuse that we've never thought of. I would prefer to move somewhat slower. I prefer to do what the Revenue Committee is looking at first, and if this will complement it,...

I didn't put a date on it. I believe Senator Hillman is acting from a position of good faith. But what has been touched on about activity in the Revenue Committee seems to be something which would be a broader, more cohesive approach. So, looking at how our system operates, I would rather see us bracket this bill (sic). Then when the Revenue Committee does whatever it's going to do, there could be, with no great amount of difficulty, as I see it, scheduling the two bills together with the Revenue bill preceding this amendment.
