SENATOR COORDSEN: The issue before the body is the adoption of the Kristensen amendment to LB 1038. All those in favor please vote aye, those opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Kristensen's amendment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The Kristensen amendment is adopted. Is there anything else on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further pending, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to advance LB 1038 to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: You've heard the motion to advance LB 1038 to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor please say aye. Those opposed no. The bill is advanced. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 1039, Senator, I have E & R amendments first of all.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 1039.

SENATOR COORDSEN: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to 1039. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Warner would move to amend. Senator, your amendment is on page 940 of the Journal. (Re: AM3353)

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this amendment is one which some of you have been asking about, deals with changes in the homestead exemption, and it is, in fact, LB 298 that was unanimously advanced from the Revenue Committee last year and it was a priority, Revenue priority bill. Included in the amendment is also an amendment that Senator
