of the state, or just outstate drivers?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: These would have been operators who were outside of the boundaries of Nebraska. In other words, we deal with the intrastate, which got their operator's license inside the state of Nebraska, but these are the drivers who are from Iowa, Missouri, Kansas, and so forth.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Okay. So it would not affect the drivers that go, that drive out of state.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: It would not affect the drivers who got their CDLs...

SENATOR JANSSEN: In Nebraska.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: ...in Nebraska using our...the federal law has all those federal physical qualification requirements, and those things are changing a little bit, but these would be operators who got their license here. If they had them prior to July 30, 1996, they're going to be grandfathered here. We just can't accommodate people coming from other states who have one. They're going to have to redo it all.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you. That answers my question. I will support the amendment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: There are no further lights on. Senator Kristensen, do you wish to close?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I'd waive closing, thank you.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Kristensen waived closing. The issue before the body is the adoption of the Kristensen amendment to LB 938. All those in favor please vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Kristensen's amendment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The Kristensen amendment is adopted. Is there any further item...are there any further items on this bill?
