CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Wehrbein amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senators Wesely and Withem would move to amend with AM3346. (Amendment may be found on page 933 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Wesely, to open on the amendment.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Madam President. This amendment is offered by Senator Withem and myself. It's brought to us by Bill Drafting. If you recall, the committee amendment that we adopted to the bill had 470 pages of amendments, and those dealt with the different statutes and brought them into the various agencies that we're reorganizing. There were just a few sections that were missed in that process, just a couple pages. And so what these do is include those and properly change the titles of those entities. So there's nothing more than like sort of a revisor's amendment. With that, I'd ask for its adoption.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Is there any discussion of the amendment? Seeing none, Senator Wesely, to close. Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the Wesely amendment to LB 1044. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.
