

other guy do it, it's our opportunity to be involved with a process that could be very helpful for all of our citizens. And I would just encourage the members of this body who have the opportunity to be involved with these studies this summer to do that. I don't think that necessarily falls on members of Health Committee, I think that anybody else in the body should be able to do that. And so I would think that should maybe address some of the concerns Senator Beutler has about if we don't get this done this year, we can do it again next year. I think we have the opportunity to work with the agencies, and they want to do it this year, I think we should go ahead and do that. Thank you.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Dierks. Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. President. I rise to support the Beutler amendment. And my, my support, or I would echo a lot of the comments that Senator Beutler has made. But one of the primary reasons why I think we should change the, change the date till July would be that as a one-house Legislature, we don't have those checks and balances that are involved in a two-house system. And when we're looking at a major restructuring such as this, it's a huge undertaking and I commend all those that are involved in trying to bring all this together. But as a result of that I think more times than not you're going to be better off by going at, about it in a, in a, not a necessarily a plodding fashion, but certainly one that gives you ample time to review and make sure that the course that you're on is the one that you intend to be on and that you end up with a, a process and a product that, that is going to accomplish the objectives set forth. So for that reason I'm going to support the Beutler amendment to just put another six months into the process. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Maurstad. Senator Engel.

SENATOR ENGEL: Mr. Chairman and members of the body, we brought Don Leuenberger in here and his staff to streamline these agencies, and we all know that they needed streamlined. I believe they're doing their job well. I don't think that we should try to micromanage everything that they do. I also believe that we can study things to death by delaying the date from January 1 to July 1 of next year. I believe that when we meet again next January that there's no reason why we wouldn't
