SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you. Senator Withem.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Debate has ceased. Senator Beutler, to close on your amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Coordsen, members of the Legislature, all I'm asking is that we take a look at this plan and this organization for merger one more time in the next legislative session, and that we do it without tying one hand behind our backs. If you have an implementation date for the division of the structure and start changing people around, and desks around and space around, and you incur all of this expense, you're putting things in a position that makes the most objective decision more difficult. And why should we do that? Because we don't trust our own judgement to go forward with something if it continues to be a good idea after we've seen some objective information. Only unless we don't trust ourselves should we tie one hand behind our back in approaching the whole subject. If you owned a large company and all your livelihood depended on it and all your kids depended on it, and your manager said, well I'm going to make a radical change in this company, I'm going to divide it up into three parts this way. No one's ever done this before with a company, but I'm going to do it this way and let me go ahead and do it and you just go south to Florida and have a good time. Would you feel comfortable with that? I don't think so. I think you would want to know, well, let me see, my financial department's going to be separate from these other departments. And how are you going to do it with this program over here for making this product? And what about that product,
