He said the Legislature has asked for cooperation, the Governor has asked for cooperation, and it hasn't happened. It hasn't happened. So we need to do it this way. Well, I'm sorry. I thought these are the same people that have ignored our pleas to work together, they are the same people that are going to be in this big agency now, the same people. And somehow they're going to just miraculously not protect their turf and they are going to share.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: I don't know how that's going to be any different from what we have now. I am not convinced of that. There's a lot of things I don't know about the bill and maybe it's my fault for not reading it carefully or maybe it's the fault of those supporting it not giving me the right information I needed, I don't know. But I don't know, for example, and Senator Klein, if you can answer this later on your time, please answer it because I don't know. How, when you combine all of the entities into the fiscal management portion, just the fiscal side, how does it work for OJS? When you give something, monies to OJS, how does that fit with the other agencies? How do they actually get together and take the dollars and shift it to one...a different program or to one entity? How are they going to do that? And I will bet you the answer is, we don't know. We are going to work out the details. Oh, by the way, we took out the confidentiality portion so they can't even share that information now. How do you do it where a computer data program is in one agency, but...
