So we're saying that we're going to change the way these departments are configured, but we have the same weak person at the top who can't handle it now, he couldn't cut the mustard then. And if he is able to cut the mustard then, he's able to cut it now and we're being sold a bill of goods. We're being snookered. You all are being snookered. You're being suckered. You are being taken to the cleaners, and the public will know it.
