We missed a few things and had some dates that were not quite right, so this is essentially an E & R amendment brought to us from the Fiscal Office to correct a few things in the bill. SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Wesely. There are no lights on. Closing's waived. Question is the adoption of the Wesely amendment to LB 1044A. All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Again, members, if you care to vote on this measure, would you please check and see if your vote has been recorded. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk, additional amendments.

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, I have an amendment by Senator Wehrbein and other members of the Appropriations Committee. It's found on page 1036. (AM3376)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Hillman, are you going to handle that?

SENATOR HILLMAN: Yes, thank you, Mr. Speaker. This amendment comes from the Appropriations Committee and its purpose is only to be able to better track and give, I think, better information on LB 1044, laying out how those budgets are to be submitted, to get the kinds of, I think, information in the different categories it's going to be necessary for us to have the kind of information that we need. And with that I would just ask for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Hillman, there are no lights on, would you like to close? Closing's waived. Please vote on the adoption of the Wehrbein amendment to LB 1044A. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. There's several members in the Chamber who do not seem to be wishing to participate in a vote on this measure. Thank you, members. Mr. Clerk, record.
