**SPEAKER WITHEM:** Senator Chambers.

**CLERK:** Page 9, strike...line 8, strike "speeding" and insert, "exceeding the posted speed limit".

**SENATOR CHAMBERS:** Yes, this is one that I want to take up, and somebody is treading on my bill. Who, I'd like to ask Senator Kristensen a question. Senator Kristensen, who offered this amendment about doubling the penalty if somebody is speeding in a construction zone?

**SENATOR KRISTENSEN:** Senator Chambers, that was Senator Coordsen's bill, and I don't remember the bill number. Went through committee and that's the policy that got put into it.

**SENATOR CHAMBERS:** Okay, and I wanted to call whoever that person is attention to what it is that I'm doing because I think you will see nothing wrong with it. So, Senator Coordsen, would you turn to page 9, and it would be of the committee amendment, and I am in line 8, and I will tell you what I'm doing. It is just what I consider clean-up language. Since my name is on the bill, I'm just a little sensitive about how we express some of the ideas. What the language says is that when there is a construction zone, then there will have to be a sign or signs to inform the motoring public that the fine will be doubled for speeding in such zones. What I want to do is strike the word "speeding" and insert "exceeding the posted speed limit." The term "speeding" really is not used in conjunction or in connection with any violations of the speed limit law. So, Senator Coordsen, the reason for my language is to just state it in a way that I would rather see in the law. That's what my motion is, and since it is such a straightforward, easy one, and I think that we should spend as much time together as we can this session, it's only appropriate that on my own bill, I begin to do that. And if you don't accept this amendment, I don't mind. If you don't accept the bill, I don't mind. I am in what a record that was played in the old days had as a title, In A Mellow Tone. They were talking about the sound of the music. People are familiar with the expression, in a mellow mood. I don't need chemicals or anything else to put me in a mellow mood. Just by an act of will, I can do it as can anybody.
