SENATOR CHAMBERS: See, he's trying to distract me. Won't take me a minute to say this though. One of those we're going to consider between 5:00 and 6:00 comes from the Ag Committee and I've going to point out some language I helped put in that bill. That's what I'm going to do. And we're just going to discuss some things and find out who's who, what's what, and where's where. This little amendment that I'm offering you I think does improve the bill and it does include the word "posted" because this change in the speed limit does have to be posted and nobody's trying to run a game on the public or make these construction zones a means by which we can derive additional revenue. I don't think any of us would want to get a nickel in fines from anybody violating this part of the law because we would rather people slow down when they come to those construction zones. But for my part, Senator Coordsen,...
