ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Wickersham's amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk, anything further?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wesely, for discussion on the motion to advance.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Two brief questions. First off, there is no expanded early retirement benefits in this bill, is that right?

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: No, there are not.

SENATOR WESELY: The second question is, that inadvertent inclusion of some in the retirement plan that weren't supposed to be, you mentioned that as part of this, but you didn't say it had been resolved and you might just take one second. And you're going to...there's some followup that will...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yeah.

SENATOR WESELY: ...occur on that (interruption)...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yeah, no, I do not...

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: I do not believe that issue has been resolved. There may be other items brought to the Legislature later in this session. The committee has been considering a resolution that would address that issue. But it, in my mind, that issue is unresolved. The attempts in this bill are simply to provide mechanisms that would allow us to avoid some of that problem, potentially, potentially. I'm not going to say that is was going to work 100 percent.
