

SENATOR ROBINSON: What's the dollars now?

CLERK: Senator Schimek has an amendment to the bill.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Pass over.

SPEAKER WITHEM: It is...actually it needs to be withdrawn. It is withdrawn at this time. If you want to refile it, you certainly may do so. Any further amendments?

CLERK: Nothing further to the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Any further discussion? Senator Wesely, to close on the bill.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Mr. Speaker, members, I apologize for the process, it is not one that I know you have a comfort level with. Let me assure you that in each of these issues they were heard by the committee, advanced by the committee unanimously.
