CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Landis' amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Notning further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to advance LB 1028 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, the question is, shall LB 1028 be advanced? All in favor vote aye. Opposed. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk, moving to General File, LB 1138.

CLERK: LB 1138, introduced by the Appropriations Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 9 of this year, referred to the Education Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have Education Committee amendments pending, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Bohlke. Good morning, Senator Bohlke.

CLERK: Senator, committee amendments and I think it's...adds the emergency clause.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Thank you, Mr. President. Senator Wehrbein has indicated that he will cover the committee amendments on this, that...from the appropriations side. Senator Wehrbein.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wehrbein, you were yielded the time to discuss the committee amendments.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes. Madam President...Mr. President and members, that the committee amendments, actually, is only the E clause, as I, Senator Bohlke, isn't that right?
