SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Landis. There are no further lights on, did you wish to say anything in closing? Closing is waived. SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. This allows for \$10,000 in the Dispute Resolution Cash Fund to be expended by the Supreme Court for Program 52. This is not a General Fund appropriation. In fact, this is just making that cash fund that we just created accessible to the Office of Dispute Resolution to spend the money they've already raised in the form of fees that they've charged for their training. I would ask for the advancement of 922A.
