Scotus Central Catholic was undefeated in the past two seasons, they won the finals in the Class I girls' state basketball tournament against Battle Creek, 44-33. I hate to say that because Senator Klein's daughter was one of the stars in Battle Creek, but, however, we did go on to claim victory. I think it was tied at the half, 17-17, if I'm not wrong there. This is not unusual to win a tournament, of course but it was theirs, Scotus' first, the girls' first title. And it made them the eighth different C-1 champion in the past eight years.
