LB 943, 1050

SENATOR BROWN: Question.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. The question before the body is, shall debate cease? All in favor please vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 5 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Debate has ceased. Senator Bernard-Stevens, to close on your motion.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: I think the issues have been very well defined. It's a question that we all just have to decide what we're going to do. And with that I would urge the support for the motion to reconsider.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. The motion before the body is to reconsider the vote on the Stuhr motion to place 943 on General File. Those who are in favor of reconsideration please vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to reconsider.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The reconsideration motion is successful. Senator Stuhr, did you wish to take up the motion to pull 943 from committee because that's where we're back to is your original motion. Would you wish this bill to be passed over at this...your bill to be passed over at this time? Senator Stuhr indicates that she wishes to pass over her motion to bring 943 to the floor at this time. The next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next item before the Legislature's consideration this morning is LB 1050, on Select File. The first item, Senator Maurstad, is consideration of Enrollment and Review amendments, Senator.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 1050.
