SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the Bernard-Stevens amendment to LB 1050. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on the Bernard-Stevens amendment. Have you all voted? Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: I would just have a call of the house and just do a roll call vote and we'll dispense with it one way or the other.

SENATOR CROSBY: There's a request for a call of the house. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: The house is under call. Would all senators record their presence. Would all senators who are not in the Chamber return and record your presence. And would all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. We're...the question that is up is the Bernard-Stevens amendment to LB 1050, and he has requested a roll call vote, which we will have when we get everybody here. Senator Bernard-Stevens, Senator Bohlke, Senator Beutler, would you like to check in. Senator Lindsay, Senator Matzke, Senator Brashear, the house is under call. Senator Chambers, Senator Robak, the house is under call. Senator Cudaback, Senator Dierks, the house is under call. Senator Engel, Senator Hudkins, the house is under call. Senator Wickersham, Senator Landis, Senator Withem, the house is under call. The question is the adoption...Senator Bernard-Stevens says we may start the roll call. CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1096-97 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 11 nays, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted. I'll raise the call. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, the next amendment I have to the bill is by Senator Maurstad. Senator, I had two amendments, the first is 3250. I have a note you want to withdraw 3250.
